Emergency Assistance

Donate new socks, underwear, and hotel size toiletries.

ROOM IN THE INN

160 congregations partner to provide shelter during the coldest months of the year.

THE GUEST HOUSE

Safe space is provided for intoxicated individuals to sober up, and shelter for those in alcohol and drug treatment.

EDUCATION AND SUPPORT

Art, literacy, spirituality, and job skills are among the many classes offered daily at the Campus, coupled with essentials such as showers, transportation and assistance in obtaining permanent housing.

ODYSSEY

Our long-term recovery program for chronically homeless men provides community and the skills needed for everyday life and work.

RESPITE CARE

We offer homeless persons who are medically fragile a safe place to recover.
