History and Virtual Tour of Room In The Inn	This one-hour session presents the history of the Room In The Inn ministry as well as a computer-based tour of the new downtown facility.
Thinking about Homelessness	Session participants will examine some of the causes and issues of homelessness as well as discuss stereotypes about people who are homeless. This can be scheduled as a one- or two-hour session.
Introduction to Addiction	Participants will gain a basic understanding about the process of addiction in this one-hour presentation.
Introduction to Mental Illness	This one-hour session will offer an introduction to the categories of mental illness and how they affect Room In The Inn guests.
Radical and Creative Hospitality	Presented in either a one- or two-hour format, the spiritual aspects of hospitality will be discussed along with innovative ways of welcoming Room In The Inn guests.
How to Listen	The session, which can be scheduled for either one or two hours, demonstrates the power of listening and provides opportunities to practice good listening skills.
The Volunteer Spirit	Participants will learn some practical strategies for being good volunteers, setting healthy boundaries, and recruiting other volunteers to join the ministry. This session lasts one hour.
The Mystery of Room In The Inn	This one-hour session will discuss the spiritual and biblical foundations of Room In The Inn. There will also be opportunities for participants to share their personal stories of how they have encountered God through this ministry.
